Dear CAREGIVERS,



"I have enjoyed our get-togethers more than I ever thought I would. This is not just a case of me providing her with help; we really like each other!"

One of the reasons we are such a perfect fit is that Wanda actually has the need for some things I can help her with: a calligraphy sign for her yard and the freely shared benefit of my computer expertise while she learns how to use email and the Internet for the first time. So I don't feel like I'm just taking and Wanda doesn't feel like she's providing all the care. This makes for a very satisfying and healthy balance in our relationship.

Wanda's help has developed into much more than rides. For example, at my request, she found Linda, a friend of hers who was happy to wash my kitchen floor now and then in exchange for me ironing her six year old's school clothes. I have a very bad back, but enjoy ironing, so I do it sitting down. Linda's arthritic hands prevent her from being able to iron comfortably, so this was the perfect solution for both.

Another of Wanda's friends, Lou Ella, has come along twice to help Wanda and Linda with my heavy housework, giving me a terrific boost. I also made a festive party of three out of my birthday lunch that Wanda planned. When I called to thank Carol for matching me with Wanda, I told her that this was truly a "marriage made in heaven." Now, I'm not just getting my errands done: Wanda's friendship and positive influence have improved the quality of my life in many unexpected ways.♥
